This offer is under the framework of a Horizon 2020 grant called MyPebs (My Personal Breast Screning); an international project, funded by the European Union that investigates whether a risk-based breast cancer screening strategy, based on a clinical risk score, is more effective than standard screening foe women aged 40 to 69 years.

Requirements of the candidates:

- To have obtained the PhD, understanding as such the date of reading and approval of the doctoral thesis, after January 1st, 2016
- To have obtained the PhD in a center other than IMIM or have completed a postdoctoral stay abroad lasting at least one year.
- Neither having a Sara Borrell contract at the time of application nor having completed it previously.
